#### SOME FACTS...

- ♦ Cane Toads eat insects, mammals, reptiles, amphibians and birds and anything that tries to eat Cane Toads will be killed too!
- ♦ The Cane Toad will destroy whole ecosystems in the Kimberley.
- ♦ Toads will directly affect tour operators, communities, Aboriginal people and directly impact on social, health and environment of all Western Australians.
- ♦ The most urgent short term action is to implement control measures such as trapping. The plan is to use the 2005 dry season to contain the toads' western advance at the Victoria River in the Northern Territory.
