National Eradication Week

STTF is calling all communities across the Top end to participate in National Cane Toad Eradication Week; from October 11th until October 19th. Imagine the possibility if we all have a go at removing cane toads from habitats,



households and communities in the Northern Territory, Queensland and northern NSW. STTF commits to being the central repository of data – we will collate, analyse and report via the web and media, the daily tally of toads removed from the Australian countryside during the National Eradication week. If you can't make it to The Great Toad Muster, this is a great way to still be involved in reclaiming back Australia from the cane toad!

- One cane toad in the NT survived in a dogs stomach for 40 minutes!
- Cane toads have no native predators in Australia
- 102 cane toads were imported to Australia in 1935; there are now roughly 200 million!
